MAJ Bostick commissioned in the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in May 2011 from the United States Military Academy at West Point, NY. His previous assignments include Platoon Leader and Executive Officer in the 20<sup>th</sup> Engineer Battalion, 36<sup>th</sup> Engineer Brigade; Aide-de-camp to the Transatlantic Division Commanding General/USACE DCG Reserve Affairs; Assistant Operations Officer for the 249<sup>th</sup> Engineer Battalion (Prime Power); Company Commander for the Asymmetric Warfare Group; and Course Director/Assistant Professor for Single Variable Calculus at the United States Military Academy.

MAJ Bostick holds a B.S. in Mechanical Engineering from the United States Military Academy and an M.S. in Mechanical Engineering from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. He is a graduate of the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College, Engineer Captain's Career Course, Engineer Basic Officer Leader Course, Route Reconnaissance Clearance Course (Leader), and Unit Movement Officer Course. He is a certified Project Management Professional (PMP) and a licensed Professional Engineer (PE) in the state of Missouri.
